

Application for Free 2010 Annual Convention Registration for Student Presenters

The Society for the Advancement of Behavior Analysis (SABA) will distribute donations from the 2009-2010 Student Presenter's Fund to qualified student applicants. Complimentary registration (but not other expenses) will be awarded to student presenters as allowed by the availability of funds and the eligibility of the student. In 2009, SABA provided convention registration for 78 students attending the 35th annual ABA International convention in Phoenix.

Eligible applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- The student must be a 2010 student member of ABAI at the time the application is submitted.
- The student must be a primary presenter (presenting author, chair, or discussant) of a poster, paper address, panel discussion, or symposium.
- The proposal must be accepted for presentation at the 2010 ABAI convention.
- This form must be completely filled out and received at the ABAI office by October 30, 2009.
